Dear Mr. O'Reilly,

I refer to your recent communication in relation to the Integrated Pollution Control Licence in respect of the above facility.

This is to advise that the HSE has no significant concern regarding the health impact of the proposed activity subject to the normal standards in relation to noise and air pollution being applied and monitored and satisfactory capacity being available in the waste water treatment plant and it's receiving waters to effectively treat the effluent.

There is a domestic shallow well (in use) approximately 80 metres North West of the buildings. I recommend that this well be included in applicants monitoring regime and that any evidence of contamination be notified to the HSE and users of the well.
