To whom it may concern.

I am writing to object to a Planning Application Ref No. W0 214/02 from O'Donoghue Waste Disposal Centre at Knockpogue, Warenjall, nr. Cork. for an increase to their capacity.

1. In 2007 they already exceeded their capacity by 9,000 tonnes from their 23,000 allowance.
2. In their last planning application it was stated that they forecast that their capacity would reduce in coming years not increase.
3. Our roads are narrow country roads and are not suited to this volume of traffic.
4. They are constantly working outside of normal trading hours with those Re-gen trucks operating at

23.00 hrs and 6.30 am. This is totally unacceptable.

5. The noise level of these trucks passing at speed past our house is and has become a huge nuisance

6. There are cars and trailers and small trucks using the facility without holding an EPA licence which is illegal.

7. O'Donoghue's own skip lorries are not using the weigh bridge so tonnage is actually a lot more than they are specifying.

8. skips are constantly overloaded causing a danger to the public as on many occasions nets are not used.

I hope you will give my objection your careful consideration and reduce their capacity instead of increasing it further
