PROPOSAL: (a)

to increase the quantum of alternative fuels from 50,000

tons to 95,000 tons per annum.

(b)

to extend the range of permitted alternative fuels to include solid recovered fuel (SRF) and tyre derived fuels

(TDF)

I have no objections to the proposal subject to the following conditions:

1. Prior to the full scale use of SRF and TDF, a test programme on the burning and combustion of these alternative fuels shall be carried out to ascertain their effect on the quality of the clinker and plant emissions.

The result of such tests shall be submitted to the EPA.

- Incoming waste which may be contaminated with hazardous or toxic materials shall be stored in a dedicated waste quarantine area prior to disposal at an appropriate facility agreed to with the EPA.
- 3. (a) There shall be no pre-treatment of SRF and TDF on site.
 - (b) The SRF and TDF shall be stored in designated bunkers. The quantity of the waste materials shall not exceed the storage capacity.
