it, this past 26 years. Since Cavan

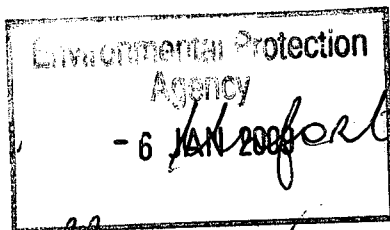
County Council decided to take rubbish

and Midlands, approximately ten years ago  
the smell has got progressively worse.

The smells are so bad at times  
I can get them in the house even though  
the windows are closed. On occasions

I have to take the clothes off the line and re-wash them as they stink from the fumes. I am unable to walk the lovely scenic route adjacent to my house, owing to the stench from the dump. When my family & friends visit I am embarrassed by the smells at my house. I have to pass the dump to go to my work and on occasions I have to cover my nose as the smell is so nauseating.

I work in an office in the centre of Baram Town, and there are times when the smell is very bad there.

I would appeal to you to refuse this application, as I will be left with no alternative only to move



house. Unfortunately I will be unable to sell my home as nobody would want to buy it. I am sick of listening to false promises from Oxigen this past year that things will improve, but from my experience the situation is getting progressively worse. This dump is too near our County town, and is in close proximity to schools and housing estates.

I would appeal to you again to refuse this application & order the closure of this dump immediately.
