I am writing to complain about the smell from the landfill site at Corranure. The foul odour from the site has progressively got worse in recent times to the point it is unbearable. This is having an impact on the health of people within the area and of particular concern is the health of our children. The location of the site is totally unsuitable as it is on the edge of a major town and a large number of people live beside it. Any leisure activities such as walking, playing outside are carried out miles away and not where we live.

The major concern is the air and water pollution that the landfill is causing. Oxygen themselves have admitted that foul odours are coming from the MRT plant. There has also been repeated breaches of EPA licences.

In light of the above the landfill site at Corranure should be closed immediately as it is a hazardous health risk to all who live beside it.
