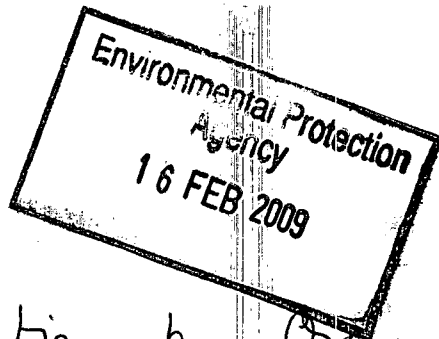

In reference to the
above application for a waste licence we
wish to object to the granting of same on
the following grounds:

1. With regards to pollution, we seriously
distrust this whole project. Promise after
promise has been made to local people
guaranteeing an end to the incessant air
pollution. However it continues. We have
simply tolerated too much already. This
gaseous smell was obvious even in the

early hours of Saturday morning, the 7th of February 2009, in spite of Oxigen's many months of empty promises.

2. This project has had a serious adverse effect on our quality of life here in Ballyhaisee. We have been forced to keep our windows closed because of the bad smell emanating from the landfill site. Best practise dictates airing one's home with fresh air. This has become impossible. As keen gardeners, we have not been able to enjoy the outdoors. Because of the fumes, it has been impossible & unhealthy to work in the garden or to sit outside & enjoy fresh air. We cannot entertain outdoors either which was a very important part of our lives before this. We have been forced to over-use our tumble-dryer at extra expense to us (and not very environmentally friendly) as we cannot dry our clothes outdoors.

For the reasons mentioned above, & for the sake of restoring some semblance of normality back to our lives, we implore the Agency to refuse this application for a licence in this matter & would urge you to ensure the closure of the present facility.
