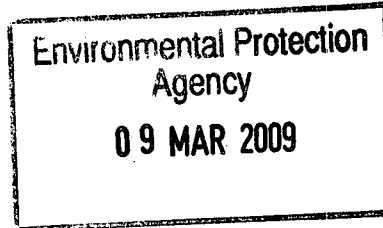

Dear Sirs

I refer to the above application and wish to make the following objection to the granting of the above for the following reasons:

I was a regular visitor to Cavan town with my family for pleasure and also to source our shopping needs.

Over the last year or so we have experienced bad odours and smells in the town and surroundings on our visits. On occasions the smells have been terrible, resulting in my young family not wanting to visit Cavan Town.

I later discovered that these odours and smells were coming from Corranure Landfill.

On our visits to Cavan Town with my young family we loved visiting the play area on Cathedral Road, where this used to be the highlight of our visit, however we no longer visit this play area and in fact we have now decided not to visit Cavan town for our weekly shop were possible but to shop locally in Ballyconnell.

I pass through Cavan on a regular basis now and I still get the smell from the Landfill when on the bypass.

The situation regarding the poor management of the landfill is unacceptable and I ask that the Environmental Protection Agency refuse this application for a licence and work towards the closure of the landfill.
