Dear Mr. Reilly,

I refer to your recent communication in relation to the Integrated Pollution Control Licence in respect of the above facility.

This is to advise that the HSE would be concerned to ensure that the water supply source for Newbliss Public Water supply, which is located downhill of this development, is adequately protected from any accidental spillage of chemicals, hydrocarbins, or organic materials stored or used in connection with the facility. The land bank shown as available for landspreading is mostly within, and uphill of this water supply source which should be strictly protected from contamination or enrichment.

If the above water supply is adequately protected, the HSE has no significant concern regarding the health impact of the proposed activity subject to the normal standards in noise and air pollution being applied having regard to the location of nearby dwellings.
