

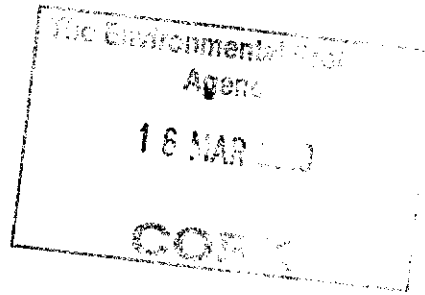

Waste Management (Licensing) Regulations 2004 (S.I. 395 of 2004).

Re: - W0264-01. Waste Licence Application from Sand & Gravel Merchants Ltd in relation to a facility/ premises located at Sand & Gravel Merchants Ltd Thornberry, Kill, Co. Kildare.

Dear Ms. Smith,

I refer to the documentation received, including a cover letter from you, dated 18th February 2009 relating to the above application. It is noted that the application proposes the

1. Recycling and reclamation of other inorganic materials.

This office has no objection to the waste licence application W0264-01 solely for the recycling and reclamation of other inorganic materials

2. Storage of waste intended for submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule.

It would appear that the inclusion of Number 2 above in this application may facilitate the carrying out the activities of recycling or reclamation of organic substances including composting and other biological processes, and for the storage of waste for any purpose.

This office recommends that should there be any alterations of the activity stated in Number 1 above it should be the subject of a separate waste licence application.
