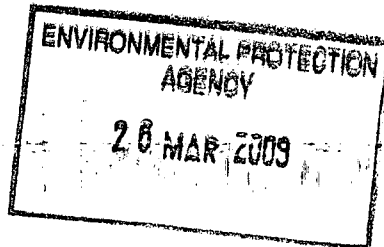

Dear Sir/Madam

Re: Application by Oxigen Environmental Ltd for a Licence to operate an Integrated Waste Management Facility at Lismagraty and Corranure Townlands, Cootehill Road, Cavan, Co. Cavan.

We have lived in close proximity to the landfill in Corranure and Lismagraty for 2 years. In that time we have had numerous instances of noxious smells originating from the facility. We notice this occurring every 4-5 days. We have to close the windows on our house, bring in clothes on the washing line and avoid outside activities when this occurs. We are concerned about the effect on our ground water supply caused by possible pollution from the landfill as we use water from a well.

We have heard from Cavan County Council and more lately Oxigen Ltd promises that this nuisance will shortly be abated. On all occasions these promises have proved to be worthless.

It is now planned to expand the facility and I have no faith that these organisations will fulfil their licence requirements for any future facility due to the fact they have been repeatedly found to be in contravention of their present licence.

I am asking the Agency to refuse this new licence application and indeed close the present facility.
