I refer to the recent correspondence relating to the above named Application submitted to the Environmental Health Department of the HSE on the 24th March 2009.

This department wishes to make the following comments:

Pest Control

Any major earthworks will pose a risk of pests if mitigation measures are not put in place. A pest control plan should be in place at all times.

Water Quality

Regular monitoring of any possible impact the development will have on ground and surface water in the vicinity must be carried out.

Noise

The main mitigation measures for noise control must be monitored to ensure the daytime construction noise limit is managed and the Waste Water Treatment Plant operates to the specified noise criteria.

Sludge Disposal

Any agricultural use of sewage disposal should be monitored to ensure there is no adverse effect on the human food chain.
