I live in close proximity to the present waste facility at Corranure, Co Cavan and I wish to lodge an objection to the application by Oxigen Environmental Ltd for the licence as referenced above.

There is an ongoing stinking odour emanating from this facility which is very offensive and a nuisance to ones enjoyment of their home and everyday life. These odours on occasion have caused me to become nauseous and I dread to even contemplate what ongoing future health risk problems these may pose to me.

I note that on numerous occasions, this facility has already failed to comply with current environmental regulations. It is obvious that the repeated breaches of current regulations by Oxigen Environmental Ltd shows their contempt for the law and gives one an indication of their future behaviour if they are granted the above license.

I therefore call on your Agency to decline the application for a licence in this matter and to enforce existing regulations in relation to this facility.
