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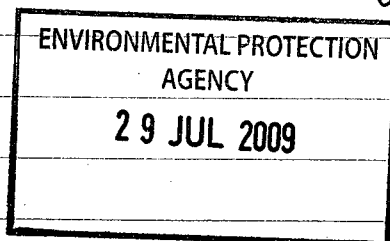

At a recent meeting with Cork Co Council it was indicated by the members present that they are applying to the E.P.A. to have a condition of the licence changed. i.e. 'that the waste coming to the landfill is mainly baled waste and only in exceptional circumstances that unbaled be accepted in the landfill.' Baled and unbaled being environmentally neutral. On requesting reference material to back this argument nothing was produced by Cork Co. Council.

I am living within 1.5-Km of the footprint

of the landfill + I am really concerned that the licence can be changed so easily by Cork Co. Council. The general feeling of locals in this area is that they want the existing licence to remain but Cork Co. Council are determined to railroad their ideas through even though locals are against it.

I attended the E.P.A. Forum in Malton for 3 weeks in order that we get the best conditions possible for the area + that we can live in harmony with this awful "landfill". He didn't want or ask for it to be visited on us but it is + we have to try + accept, but we ~~not~~ rely on the EPA to be vigilant on our behalf + when the licence + conditions were made surely it shouldn't be ~~so~~ changed with the stroke of a pen before the landfill even opens.

at the information meetings held in ~~the~~ February 2009 & again in June 2009 it was very obvious that the general feeling was that people could accept baled waste but unbaled was unacceptable. Both meetings were very heated and we really felt we were talking to a brick wall and that the Council would have no problem in getting the amendment with the stroke of a pen. The Council were asked to convey to you our objections but I really wouldn't hold my breath on that. Therefore I feel I had to write to you voicing my objections to any change in the licence.
