On Behalf of Glenville community council would like to bring to your attention the concerns of the Local Community in relation to the amendment to the Waste Licence for the bottlehill Landfill as discussed at a recent meeting of the community council in Glenville.

The main concern is with the proposal to transport of the waste un-baled to the site.

- 1. With un-baled waste being transported the increased traffic created as a result of non-compaction of the waste compared to that of baled waste requires a detailed analysis to be submitted to compared the load factor of the vehicles transporting the material baled and un-baled.
- 2. The material being transported must be transported in a sealed container and a condition of the licence should it be approved must specify no open transport of material be allowed to be allowed.
