**Application for Technical Amendment to Waste Licence**

Dear Sir:

On Behalf of Glenville community council I would like to bring to your attention the concerns of the Local Community in relation to the amendment to the Waste Licence for the bottlehill Landfill as discussed at a recent meeting of the community council in Glenville.

The main concern is with the proposal to transport of the waste un-baled to the site.

1. With un-baled waste being transported the increased traffic created as a result of non-compaction of the waste compared to that of baled waste requires a detailed analysis to be submitted to compared the load factor of the vehicles transporting the material baled and un-baled.
2. The material being transported must be transported in a sealed container and a condition of the licence should it be approved must specify no open transport of material be allowed to be allowed.
