

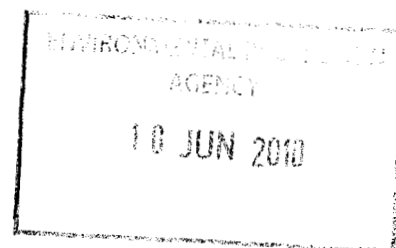

**Re: Application for an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control Licence by  
Ivan Reynolds for a poultry farm at Gerrardstown, Garlow Cross, Navan,  
Co Meath  
Ref: P0917-01**

In order to properly assess this application the applicant should be requested to submit the following FI.

**1. Proposed land for manure spreading**

The applicant should submit: -

- Maps to a scale of 1:2500 clearly identifying the lands to be used.
  - The written agreements from the land owners regarding acceptance of the manure and this should include a minimum time period for same
  - "Nutrient Management Plans" for the above mentioned lands – to take account of the nutrient content of the manure, the nutrient requirements of the crops, the nutrient status of the soils and other organic manures and chemical fertilizers being spread.
  - Details of site investigations to determine the vulnerability of the lands to be used for spreading eg., depth to water table, depth to bedrock, soil permeabilities, locations of private/public wells within 200 metres and 1 kilometre respectively of the land spreading areas, locations of water courses, land surface gradients etc.
2. Specific details relating to the on-site soiled water storage to include – location, capacity, anticipated discharge and method of disposal of the soiled water.
3. Type and location of the existing on-site "Foul Waste Water Treatment System" serving the toilet, sinks etc.
4. Specific details relating to the on-site well to include: -
- Location, type, capacity, treatment details (if any) and baseline data regarding the existing water quality. Also, the applicant indicates a proposed annual water usage figure of 7,500 – 8,500m<sup>3</sup>. A breakdown of the above figure should be given i.e., approximate demands for feeding poultry, domestic use,

wash water etc. If wheel/vehicle washing facilities are provided, then, details pertaining to same should be included.

5. Specific details relating to the existing "Fly and Pest Control Programme" in addition to the proposed extended programme.
6. Detailed procedures to be implemented in the event of an outbreak of disease requiring re-stocking ie. carcass disposal and building disinfection requirements, etc.
7. Detail of amounts of waste (excluding manure) currently generated on a weekly/annual basis. This information is essential in order to assess the additional capacity and type of storage required.
8. Measures to be implemented during storage, transport and subsequent spreading of manure to prevent odour nuisance.
9. Details of the composition of food additives with particular reference to antibiotics and heavy metals. If the above are present, then, the applicant as part of the FI should specifically address the potential polluting effects of the presence of the residues of these products in the land spreading process.

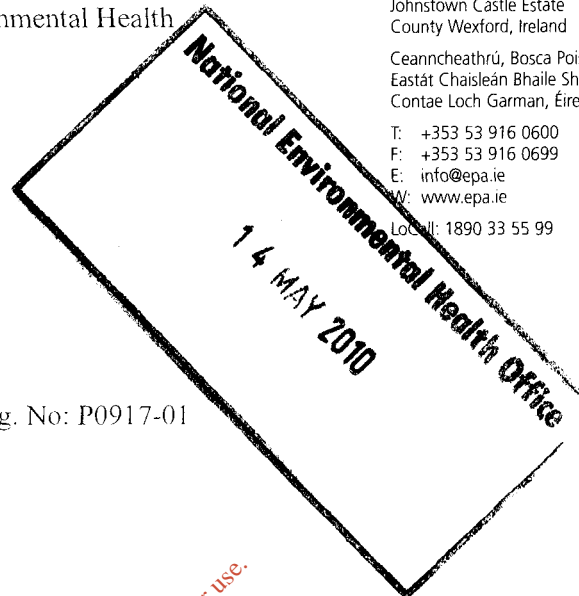


