Housing Loans/Grants 047 30527 In general with regard to the disposal of manures this Council would have concerns with the cumulative effects of manure disposal if the exemption under Human Resource Article 34 (3) of SI No 101 of 2009 (Nitrates Regulations) resulted in the Management 047 30586 application of phosphorus in excess of crop requirement particularly in sensitive catchments, areas of gley soils, areas of significant landslope, areas of extreme Motor Tax groundwater vulnerability, eutrophic lake catchments and water supply source 047 81175 catchments.
