- The applicant is required to arrange the publication of a local Marine Notice prior to commencement of operations. This notice should give a brief description of the work to be undertaken, the method of dredging and a time scale in order to give as much notice and information to port users.
- All vessels employed in the operation must satisfy Irish statutory and International certification requirements and be manned in accordance with S.T.C.W.
