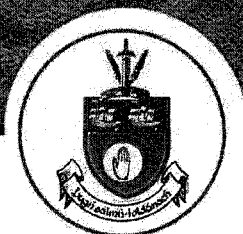

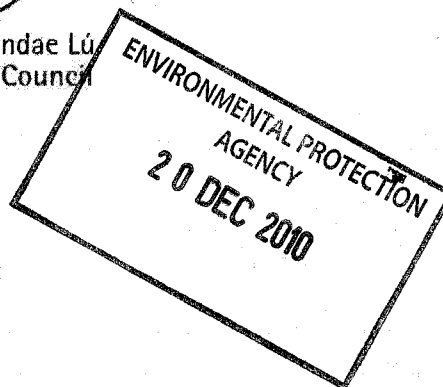

RE: IPPC Licence Amendment (PO 508-03)

A chara,

We have received correspondence from Xerox (Europe) Limited, Xerox Technology Park, Dublin Road, Dundalk, Co Louth whereby they are requesting an amendment to their current IPPC licence (PO 508-03). This amendment relates to the ph limit of the effluent from the Colour Toner plant to the local authority sewer. Accordingly Louth County Council confirms that we have no objection to an increase in the ph limit from 9.0 to 10. We request that in so far as possible, the discharge should be managed such that the smallest practicable volume is discharged at more frequent intervals as opposed to less frequent larger discharges.
