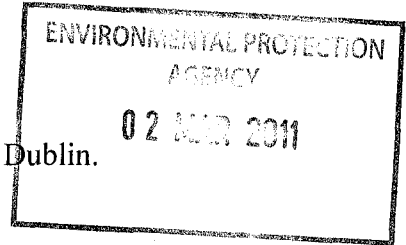

Re: Application to the EPA by Murphy Environmental Hollywood Ltd. For a Hazardous Waste Licence for a facility at Hollywood Great, Nags Head, Naul, Co Dublin.

Waste License W0129-03

We wish to make a submission regarding the proposed Waste Management Facility at Hollywood Great, Nags Head, Naul, Co Dublin – by Murphy Environmental Ltd.

Our main objection is the proposal to accept non-biodegradable inert, non hazardous and hazardous waste.

As residents of Jordanstown, Lusk, we live on the Nevitt Road and farm in this area. One of the many concerns we have is that the stream which runs through our land also flows through the town land of Tooman, which is adjacent to this Murphy Environment Quarry. Last year this stream became blocked with silt under the M1 bridge, on the Nevitt Road, and it is my opinion that this silt originated from this particular Murphy Quarry. This quarry has been accepting construction and demolition and other inert wastes. If silt can travel downstream I'm sure any number of hazardous wastes can travel. Fingal County Council spent several days unblocking this culvert under the motorway. As our main enterprise on the farm is the breeding and rearing of cattle and sheep this stream is used as part of the working farm. It is of utmost importance that this stream is kept uncontaminated.

We also find the idea of transporting hazardous waste around the country, particularly by our front door, totally unacceptable. This is an unnecessary hazard to human life and threatening the quality of all our lives.

For the sake of our environment and our health, we would sincerely hope that you will take into consideration our grave concerns, and refuse permission for this Facility.
