Submission re IPPC Licence Application Ref. No. P0942-01, Mr. Derek Good, Ardnaclug, Innishannon, Co. Cork.

I refer to the above IPPC application which was referred to Cork County Council for comment.

I have the following comments to make on the application, primarily dealing with proposals for the management of poultry litter;

- 1. The applicant refers throughout the application to S.I 378 of 2006, it should be noted that this was superseded by S.I. 610 of 2010.
- 2. The applicant states that approx. 600 tonnes of poultry litter will be generated annually on site. Table 8 in S.I. 610 of 2010 states that the P content of Broiler Poultry Litter is 6 kg/T. On this basis the annual poultry litter produced on site will contain an estimated 3,600kg of P.

 However if Table 6 of S.I. 610 of 2010 is used to calculate P produced in poultry litter the estimated P produced by the 88,000 broiler places on site is 7920 kg P. Clearly there is an inconsistency between these figures which should be clarified by the applicant.
- 3. On pages 34 & 35 of the Application Form the applicant sets out a table which identifies the lands which will be used for recovery of this poultry litter. This table states that poultry litter contains 3.51 kg P/T.

 It is noted that Table 8 in S.I. 610 of 2010 states that the P content of Broiler Poultry Litter is 6 kg/T.

 If the figure of 6kg P/t is correct then the applicant has not identified sufficient lands to recover the poultry manure. This should be clarified by the applicant.
- 4. On pages 34 & 35 of the Application Form the applicant refers to Plot 52 receiving 82.26 T of poultry litter or 21.37T/ha.

 This application rate will result in an organic N loading of 235 kg N /ha from livestock manure, (11kg N /T poultry litter as per Table 8 in S.I. 610 of 2010), which is in breach of Article 20 of S.I. 610 of 2010.
- 5. The applicant has not demonstrated that there are facilities provided for 26 weeks storage of poultry manure in accordance with Article 10 of S.I. 610 of 2010.
- 6. Very little information is provided on the lands which are proposed for the recovery of poultry litter from this unit other than the table on pages 34 & 35 of the application form.
