To whom it may concern,

I am writing this letter to place my objection to the proposed TOXIC FACILITY AT HOLLYWOOD. I would like this letter to be lodged as a submission.

I do not believe a waste licence should be granted to MEHL LIMITED by the EPA for the following reasons

1. The facility will be used as a landfill for toxic ash which contains harmful DIOXINS which are known to be carcinogenic.
2. There are also numerous Heavy Metals in the toxic material. These will ultimately leech into surrounding lands and cause unknown harm. This is especially important to the many vegetable growers and beef farmers in the immediate vicinity
3. It is inevitable that dust will be blown from the trucks during transport and this will be carried as an aerosol with the prevailing therefore being inhaled by people/livestock/bloodstock downwind of the facility.
4. There is a childrens football pitch (Ballscadden FC under 8s and under 10s) approximately 1.5km from the proposed facility and this is inside the 3km test range which was mentioned in the Environmental impact statement.
5. The increase in traffic flow due to the trucks will bring extra noise/dust/emissions to a quiet country area.

The community in the surrounding area is a strong one and most of us are involved in the agricultural/farming sector which is one of the few sectors managing to remain profitable and sustainable in the current recession. The

approval and granting of this facility will surely decimate our agricultural businesses forever and thus destroy another thriving local community.
