Dear Waste Licensing Department,

I wish to lodge my objection against the Proposed Toxic Facility at Hollywood, Naul, Co. Dublin. My reasons are:

1) Bog of Ring aquifer proximity:

The proposed Toxic Facility would be located extremely close to the Aquifer at Bog of Ring. Due to the close proximity, I would not be confident that non-contamination of this water source can be guaranteed.

2) Health Hazard to local community :

Should the EPA allow the Proposed Toxic Facility to go ahead, local people could be subjected to many illnesses, especially those with respiratory issues.

3) Destruction of local amenity

As I am sure you are aware, there is not a huge selection of activities for young or old people to do in a rural area. A huge source of enjoyment for local people is to walk or cycle in the clean fresh air. Should the EPA allow this Toxic Facility to go ahead, it is effectively taking away the one local amenity that is available in the area. This will be a huge loss to the community.

4) Extra traffic on roads

Aside from the danger that up to 500 additional truck movements will impose on our unsuitable roads, the fumes etc from these trucks will further pollute the local environment.

5) Farms in area

There are many farmers in the locality. To allow this facility to go ahead would impose a danger on their livestock and vegetables.

For the sake of the environment and community in this rural area, I hope you do not allow the Proposed Toxic Facility to proceed.
