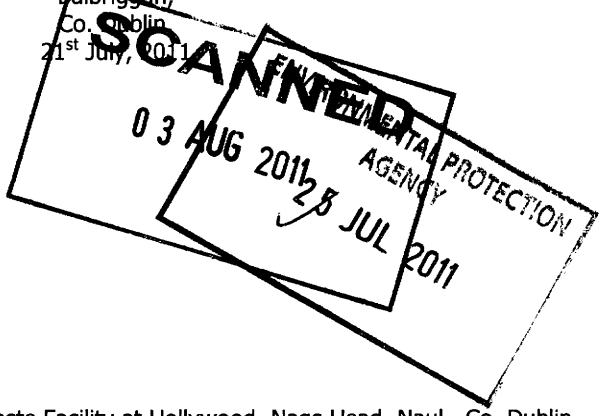

Dear Sir,

I refer to the above application and would like to make the following submission :

I am a father, living and working in Balbriggan and have grave concerns for the health and safety of the population of the town of Balbriggan should this proposed facility go ahead. I am concerned that dust emissions from the site will become airborne and travel to Balbriggan and that we will end up with a toxic ash plume over our town. My son and my stepdaughter both suffer from asthma and I am very worried regarding this.

I am also concerned for the local water supply and the Bog of the Ring Acquirer and the contamination that will be caused to it should the facility go ahead.

The proposed facility is located in an agricultural area and as such the food chain is liable to contamination from toxic dust emissions. My health and the health of my family and friends is very important to me and I have an allotment close to the proposed facility and engage in the production of organic fruit and vegetables. I can no longer continue with this activity should the waste licence be granted as my crops would become poisonous and unsuitable for human consumption.

I urge you to reject this application
