Dear Mr Meaney

Further to the above and my recent submission dated 17th June 2011 I once again write to strenuously object to the granting of a waste licence for hazardous landfill at Hollywood, Lusk.

In 2008 planning permission was refused to MEHL on the grounds that:

"the entrance, nature of business and the increased traffic flow would be injurious to the local residents in the surrounding area".

It is the EPA's responsibility to ensure that the fundamental rights of all Irish citizens are met including the right to clean air, protected water resources and soil. Bearing this in mind it is incomprehensible that such an application is being considered which has the potential to undoubtedly jeopardise and possibly lead to catastrophic consequences to the health and safety of local residents and the surrounding area.

For the record, I feel that it would be grossly negligent on the part of the EPA to grant such a licence. If such licence is approved, I would like to formally request a written guarantee from the EPA, backed by an independent report confirming that the health and safety of my family will not in any way be affected or at risk as a direct result of such approval. In the event my family suffers from any adverse health, safety or environmental affects as a direct result of this licence being granted I feel I would have no choice but to hold the EPA responsible and seek negotiations for relocation and/or compensation.
