I Paul Boland of Killiskillen, Kinnegad have experienced and issue with the water quality of my well.

I commissioned a test which was carried out by Network Water Analysis in the 15th March 2011. The results of the test are as follows:

Fe; iron 3.53

MN; manganese.1.29

As the water quality does not meet EU standards I am not eligible for the Government Grants which my neighbors have received. They have also had their wells replaced as their water quality was of a higher standard.

I feel and am advised that due to my property being located in such proximity to the Lagan Cement Operations that this has caused the high levels of manganese in my well.

The depreciation in the quality of the water quality in myswell, along with the continued blasting from Lagan Cement which has greatly upset my wife and children, is another burden my family must bear due the proximity of the Lagan Cement Operations. Due to the high levels of manganese I have to buy water for drinking and we cannot bathe our children but have to give them showers due to the risk of our children drinking the water.
