In section B.1 of EPA License Review Form and Guidance Note, temperature is one of the listed compulsorily parameters to be monitored and the results submitted in table D.1 (i) by the applicant.

Temperature monitoring data results do not appear In Table D.1(i) of attachment B.1 of the applicant's license review application submission.

The monitoring of additional parameters identified by the applicant from the list on Table 10 of schedule 5: Criteria for Calculating Surface Water Ecological Status and Ecological Potential of EC Environmental Objectives (Surface Water) Regulations 2009 were undertaken on four dates between July and August 2011.

It is recommended that the EPA establish if this monitoring is representative.

In section 1.1 of Attachment D of the applicant's license review application, the applicant assumes that for the purpose of this review, the receiving water body is the Nenagh River. The applicant's emissions are discharged to the Clareen stream prior to entering the Nenagh River.

It is recommended that the EPA clarify the appropriate receiving water body with the applicant for the purpose of this license review under the EC Environmental Objectives (Surface Water) Regulations 2009

In Section 1 of Attachment B of the applicants license review application, the applicant states that the facility has three storm water emission points at RW1, RW2 and RW3 and due to the fact that these discharge points are for the purposes of discharging surface water, these discharge locations have not been considered any further in the IPPC License Review document.

It is recommended that the EPA clarify with the applicant if it is appropriate to consider all discharges to the receiving water body from the facility including the three storm water emission points RW1, RW2 and RW3.
