

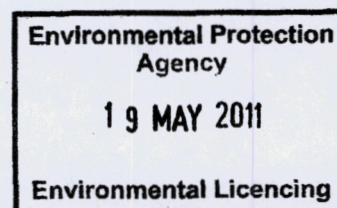
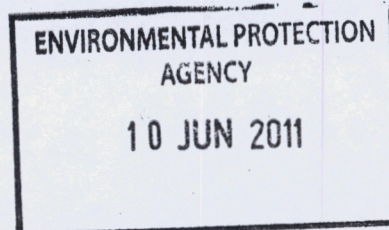

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To whom it may concern,

My name is Paul Boland I have been living in Kinnegad for the last 11 years, during the last 5-6 years the blasting coming from Lagan Cement factory has had serious effects on my home and my family.

I have contacted Lagan about this problem personally and through my solicitor, but it had little to no effect on their proceedings to the blasting and nothing has changed. My daughters psychological personalities are being detrimentally affected through this as you can see by the report I have attached by a child psychologist.


After paying for a new extension to my family home I have seen cracks appear throughout the house and have been told my chimney is about to fall down and needs to be replaced. My well also went dry and I contacted Lagan cement to which they replied by tapping me into a different well on their property which also went dry the next day, so I had to replace my well myself at my own cost of €3000.

I am a family man trying to bring up my children but in order to do this I have to provide them with the three basic needs in life which is food, shelter and safety, these three needs are currently not being fulfilled as my home is not safe and the surroundings shake when blasts occur, I am finding it hard to provide for my family when things such as my well needs replacing and my house is vibrating and cracking before my eyes, but yet they are not breaking there EPA vibrating limits.

I feel that their limits are way too high as my family should not be affected and my home should be safe. By granting Lagan cement this license I fear it will have psychological effects of my children throughout their adult lives as it has been shown in the report.
