I refer to your recent notification with respect to the above. Outlined below are the nature conservation observations of the Department of Arts, Heritage and the Gaeltacht, for your consideration..

This factory discharges into the Sruhaneballiv stream within 1.5 km upstream of where it is designated an SAC, which is a tributary of the River Awbeg SAC and is part of the River Blackwater SAC 2170. This Department recommends that an appropriate assessment screening report be undertaken to assess any potential impacts downstream in the SAC. This report should be forwarded to the Department as further information.


