

### **Section B**

In the application, it states that Tables B1(i) and B.1(ii) have been completed for the 4 emission points;

SW1 – Storm waters, Cooling waters and RO water  
SW2 – Storm waters, Cooling waters and RO water  
SW3 – Storm waters, Cooling waters and RO water  
SW4 – Treated effluent from the Waste Water  
Treatment Plant

however, the attachment only contains completed tables for SW4. In Table B.1(ii) the parameters Ammonia and Total Nitrogen as N exceed the license limits. Results have not been provided for all the parameters listed in this table.

Section B2 states that SW1, SW2 and SW3 are sampled and monitored at locations immediately prior to the waters leaving the dairy site. The three surface waters then combine in one pipe and are diverted to the Town Lough together. The emission point to the lake is located at 630770, 807701. However, these same reference points are given for SW1 in Table B2, which seems to contradict what has been stated. This requires clarification.

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
