RE IPPC Licence Application P0403-02 Dairygold Mallow

I refer to the above application.

Dairygold is an existing facility which has been in existence for many years, and the discharge from this facility uses up some of the assimilative capacity of the River Blackwater. The discharge detailed in the IPPC licence application lies approx 1km west and upstream of Mallow WWTP.

Cork County Council have made an application to the EPA for WWDA licence for the Mallow agglomeration including the WWTP ( Reg no 0052-01). This application is still currently under assessment. Cork County Council are not aware to date of the effluent discharge limits that will be applied to our WWDA licence for Mallow, but it would be important that Dairygold be similarly limited, so as not to use up more than their share of the existing freeboard capacity of the river.
