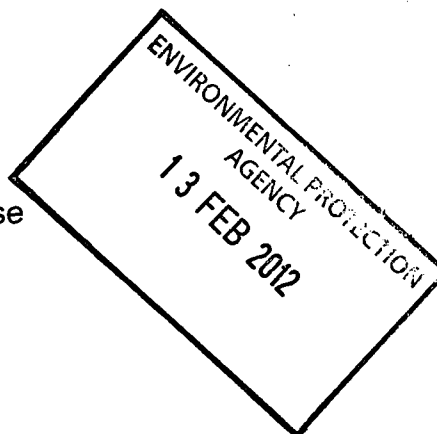

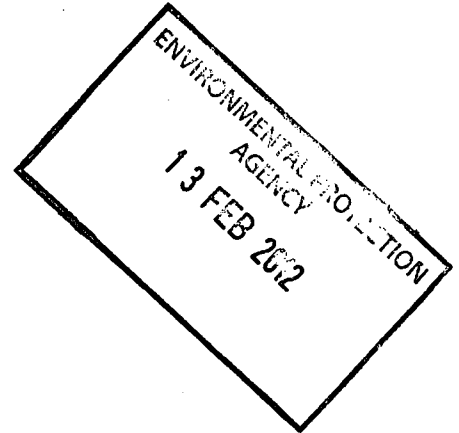

Section B

Information on the quality of the 5 surface water discharges and groundwater monitoring carried out has not been included in the application. There is not a separate table B.1 completed for each emission point.

Section C

Table C.2 (i) has not been completed for the 5 surface water discharges.

Sludge Management

It should be ensured that the company's Sludge Management Plan is in compliance with S.I. 610 of 2010 The European Communities (Good Agricultural Practice for protection of Waters) Regulations.

Company Review

As highlighted in the application, in respect of orthophosphate/MRP the current discharge emission limit value is insufficient to attain Good Quality status by 2012, in accordance with the 2009 regulations (SI No.272 of 2009). Liffey meats Ltd. are carrying out a review of this and the HSE awaits the outcome of this review.
