I refer to your e-mail of 10<sup>th</sup> February last in relation to the above application for a Dumping at Sea Permit and the request for a Technical Amendment to same.

- 1. The disposal and capping operation proposed in this case is not unique. This method has been used in other countries and, at least in principle, can be considered to be a practical approach to dealing with the contaminated sediments found in Arklow Harbour.
- 2. In all cases involving disposal and capping operations there will be a time lag between the placement of the contaminated material in the excavated pit and its subsequent capping with non-contaminated clean material. During this time the contaminated material is exposed to wave and current action.
- 3. Proposal No. 2 set out in the letter of 8<sup>th</sup> February 2011 from J P Byrne Consulting Engineers (Section 5(2) Reply, 09/02/2012) proposes a "semi-continuous" disposar and capping operation and suggests that no contaminated material would be exposed to wave and current action for more than 2 weeks.
- 4. I am of the view that, provided the applicant can demonstrate to the Agency e.g. by way of a detailed method statement that this proposal is technically feasible using the plant and equipment as proposed, this proposal represents a practical and reasonable approach and one which is not likely to result in significant adverse impacts on the marine environment or other legitimate users / uses of the area.
