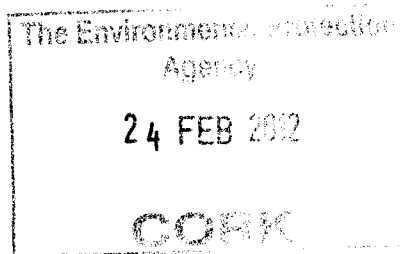

APPLICATION FOR INTEGRATED POLLUTION PREVENTION AND CONTROL

Dear Sir,

Our firm have been asked to represent local residents, residing in the area of Kilcolman, Asdee, Listowel, County Kerry.

My clients wish to object to the application by Brandon Products Limited for an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control Licence.

The factory is in a location with considerable number of local houses.

The factory obtained planning initially on the basis that there would be no emissions (smells or noises) from the facility and that it would be an organic facility.

Notwithstanding conditions in original planning authorisation reference 3080/06, the factory has in fact, from the start, used chemicals in its process and has emitted odours and has caused substantial noise pollution.

The operators of the facility have shown no regard for planning legislation or the conditions of planning granted to it.

The proposed Pollution Prevention and Control Licence should not be granted because this factory is in a totally unsuitable place for such a facility.

The operation of the factory has to date, and will in the future caused substantial problems for local residents. The factory is built on a main access road to tourist destinations in North Kerry and is not far from various seaside resorts. There are 22 houses almost of all of which are occupied within 250 metres of the facility. The facility is housed in a former creamery building which is totally unsuited for the industrial process being carried out in the building. Please acknowledge receipt of this letter.
