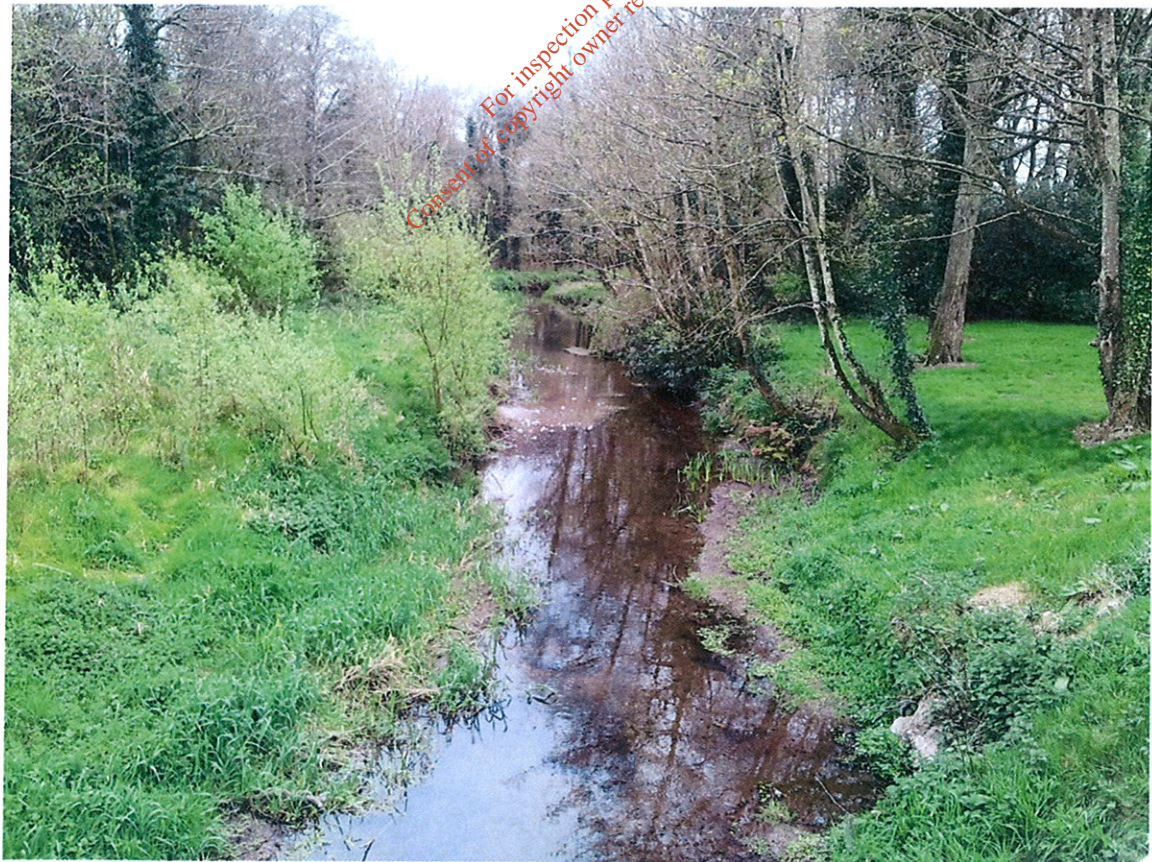
To me and to the residents of Castlemartyr this is unacceptable.
