Dear Claire,

I refer to the recent submissions of further information from Mr. Meredith Moore concerning the proposed poultry operation at Legnakelly, Clones, Co Cavan.

In addition to the issues highlighted in the HSE report dated 09 February 2012, I would further advise, following a site visit, of the following concerns:

- The bore well located in the main yard adjacent to the poultry units, is unsuitably covered/protected to prevent contamination from yard washing and surface water run off. Remedial work on the said cover needs immediate attention.
- Before construction to extend the soiled water tank commences, the
 existing tank should be emptied completely and cleaned sufficiently to
 ensure that soiled water does not enter the storm water drainage system
 adjacent to the tank and subsequently the ground water course.

It would also be advisable to ensure, before backfilling commences, that
the new tanks suitability to store soiled water is of sound construction in
terms of ensuring that there is no leakage to the adjacent storm water
drainage system from failures in the new construction.
