Further to previous submissions and objections to the above, I wish to make the following submission before EPA's close of business today, the 5th July 2012: (1) <u>I support the Objection from Peter Sweetman & Associates</u> as an Elected Public Representative, I am opposed to Ireland/EPA's breach of the European Court of Justice in Case C-50/09 in granting IPPC licence to Boliden Tara Mines Itd

(2) I support the Objection from An Taisce as The National Trust for Ireland, as an Elected Public Representative I am opposed to Ireland/EPA's breach of the European Court of Justice in Case C-50/09 in EPA's decision grant to Boliden Tara Mines Ita. their IPPC Licence - the issues raised in An Taisce's Objection are well made - in particular the issue of potential impacts due to concentrated rainfall or Climate Change - these have not been properly investigated by either Meath County Council or the EPA. The EPA must respect C-50/09 re this IPPC licence. Dear Clr. Cantwell

Thank you for telephoning me yesterday in order to express your concerns regarding the above. As you may well know Inland Fisheries Ireland (IFI) is a Statutory Body established on the 1st July 2010 replacing the Regional Fisheries Boards (inc. the Eastern Regional Fisheries Board). Under section 7(1) of the Inland Fisheries Act 2010 (No. 10 of 2010) the principal function of IFI is the protection, management and conservation of the inland fisheries resource.

Under section 7(3) of the IFI Act it is stated that without prejudice to subsection (1), IFI shall in the performance of its functions have regard to:

(g) the requirements of the European Communities (Natural Habitats) Regulations 1997 (S.I. No. 94 of 1997) and the need for the sustainable development of the inland fisheries resource (including the conservation of fish and other species of fauna and flora habitats and the blodiversity of inland water ecosystems),

(h) as far as possible, ensure that its activities are carried out so as to protect the national heritage (within the meaning of the Heritage Act 1995).

We would be anxious that the EPA would address all your concerns in a satisfactory manner (such as the extension to the tailings pond) if you decide to object or seek an oral hearing regarding the proposed determination. We would also be anxious that the EPA would address any matters relevant to fisheries interests regarding the various discharges to waters, especially with regard to the antimony. Also Article 5 of the 2009 Surface water Regulations requires that a public authority, in performance of its functions, shall not undertake those functions in a manner that knowingly causes or allows deterioration in the chemical or ecological status of a body of surface water.
