We Peter and Diane O'Leary wish to make an additional submission on the licence review regarding KWD Recycling Ltd registration number W0217-02.

Further to our correspondence dated the 23/11/2011 to your office, we would like to add the following.

- The increasing annoyance we are experiencing from this recycling unit on a daily basis. The volume of HGVs/trucks and general movement of trade traffic to and from this facility, has increased dramatically over the past twelve months.
- My children and I are regularly awoken between the hours of 4am and 5am due to the movement of HGVs/Trucks from the KWD depot. As you can imagine this is causing great distress to us as a family. We are very concerned that if KWD were to be granted an increase to their existing tonnage what effect this would have on us
- The increase in the volume of HGVs/trucks is also a safety issue because of the speed they are travelling at, morning to night.
- We have evidence that this facility is operating outside its current licensing agreement including Bank Holidays etc..

When making a decision on the licence review for this facility we hope you will take these and our previous concerns into consideration.
