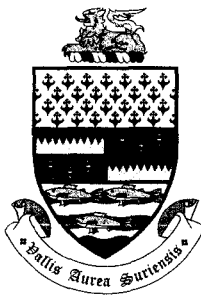

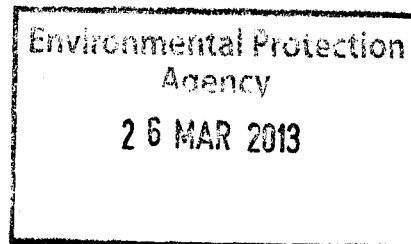

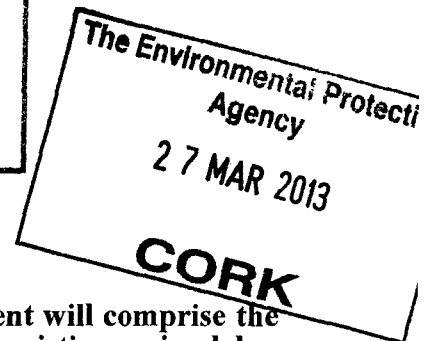

Re: Anglo Beef Processors Ireland PERMISSION for development will comprise the demolition of buildings and structures on the site including an existing animal by-product processing building, workshop, office and stores (gross floor area c2,775sq.m) towards the south-western part of the site and the construction of a new animal by-product processing building (with associated roof-mounted plant including condensers) and covered silos (gross floor area c5,056sq.m including mezzanines, silos and maximum height of c21.5 metres) also in the south-western part of the site, workshop, new covered silos adjacent to existing processing building towards the centre of the site, relocation of water storage tanks, new biofilter, and 15 additional car parking spaces. Access to the site will be via existing and established vehicular access points off the local road L3120. The application also provides for lighting and signage as well as all associated site development works including pipe-bridges, boundary treatment, landscaping and planting. The application will be accompanied by an Environmental Impact Statement. The application relates to an activity requiring an Integrated Pollution and Prevention Control License at Kilcommon Cahir Co. Tipperary


