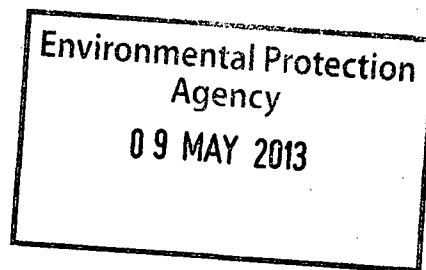

Further to my submissions to you, dated 04-02-2013 in error - it should have been 04-01-2013, regarding problems with bright/glaring lights, shining into our home and garden for over three years now, from Lakeland Dairies, Killeshandra, I wish to inform you that ten lights are still not tilted down to light up Lakeland Properties - that is on our side of Lakelands only - and affecting us. (There are numerous other such lights all over and around their properties). However, one very bright glaring light was switched off on a Monday in April, together with 2 or 3 others which appeared to be on the same 'time-switch'. This one, very bright light was a blinder and was badly in need of adjustment, so that is a great plus. I just hope that this is not a temporary measure, as Lakelands did this before and, then switched everything back on, when clocks went back in October.

The remaining lights have not been touched / remedied.

They are as follows :- Two in canteen car park, two on new casein plant extension and three or four on U.H.T. / U.H.T. Dispatch.

There are two more lights, recently installed, one across from the canteen on the end of a red brick building over a black doorway.

The other one is near the green silo which is situated close to the U.H.T. / U.H.T. - dispatch structure.

Would you kindly compel Lakeland Dairies to address this ongoing nuisance, as soon as possible.
