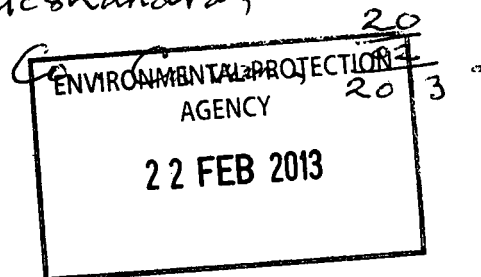

Further to my submission to you
dated, *04-02-2013, in relation to
application by Lakeland Dairies Co-operative
Society Ltd., Killeshandra to E.P.A.
for review of their current I.P.P.C.
licence at Killeshandra Dairies site,
(PO 800-03), whereby Lakeland Dairies are
to submit information to E.P.A under
the requirements of Class 7.2.1. for
treatment and processing of milk, the
quantity of milk received being greater
than 200 tonnes per day etc. etc.,
I neglected to document a serious
environmental matter which has been
'ongoing' for a long period of time now.

There is a considerable and
continuous stream of water/? flowing out
to the main road. It is coming down
a 'right of way' and 'adjoining field'
and out from a mound of clay beside
the right hand pier at a gateway, along the
public road, on the extreme right of Lakelands.

This is all happening just to the right of a number of Lakeland Dairy structures, which are in operation.

This substance continues to flow down along the public road and, footpath for some distance where it eventually finds a gully.!!

There is also more water/? flowing, apparently from the same source and, exiting the 'adjoining field' through a hole in a wall to the right of the gateway and right beside it.

This water enters a gully on the side of the wall facing the public road.

The manner in which this water/? is being disposed of is unacceptable, disgusting and unsightly.

It is definitely not environmentally friendly.

It is also a health hazard as part of the flow becomes frozen over in winter and people on foot, including myself have to walk there, going/coming to town.

I feel that this problem needs to be addressed at source and not allowed near the public road nor footpath. Will you please investigate and take appropriate action.
