My partner and I along with our 3 kids aged 4 years 3 years and 1 year live at 127 mill road Bandon cork, which is a county council house. In the proximity of the back yard 30 feet from the back door is a stage 1 treatment facility. We have only lived here about 2 years yet in that two years the kids and ourselves have had numerous bronchial infections ear nose and throat infection, which our gp puts down to the treatment plants emitting gasses etc.,

- As the smell is nauseating and abhorrent we do not venture into the garden as it is not an enjoyable place to be even in summer months.
- My son Kai has to take steroids for his airways he never had to be on these in our previous home.
- My GP has said the problems we are getting in relation to our health would be greatly improved if we moved away.
- We cannot open our windows and spend a lot of time away from home as the smell can be bad.
- He premises is unlicensed and the employees told methey get it emptied a lot more than normal as the filtering machine stopped working and they don't have the budget to do repairs

This facility is not functioning as two intended and as a result the residents and workers in the area have to smell faeces all day

I would like to lodge an objection to the licence of this place until it is functioning in proper order with no smells
