

An Bord Pleanála has received the additional information requested by it in relation to the above-mentioned proposed development. As the Board considers that this additional information contains significant additional data in relation to the likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, the likely consequences for proper planning and sustainable development in the area in which it is proposed to situate the said development of such development, and the likely significant effects of the proposed development on a European site, it hereby requires you in accordance with section 175(5)(d) and section 177AE(5)(d) of the Planning and Development Act, 2000, as amended, to

- publish in the same newspaper in which notice of the original application was advertised a notice stating that significant additional information in relation to the said effects has been furnished to the Board, that the additional information will be available, for inspection or for purchase (on payment of a specified fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy), at a specified place and at specified times during a specified period, and that submissions or observations in relation to the additional information may be made in writing to the Board before a specified date, and
- (b) send notice of the furnishing to the Board of significant additional information, and a copy of the additional information, to the prescribed bodies and indicate that submissions or observations in relation to the additional information may be made in writing to the Board before a specified date.

The additional information should be made available for inspection or purchase at the same locations at which the original application documentation was available. In respect of the time limits for the making of submissions or observations in relation to the additional information to the Board under (a) and (b) above please indicate the specified time limit for the receipt of submissions to be not later than 5.30p.m. on the 14th of March, 2014 in both cases.

You should submit the relevant newspaper notices and a copy of any notices issued under (b) above to the Board as soon as same are available. Your response to this letter should be received not later than 5.30pm on the 28th of February, 2014.
