Dear Sir,

I read your notice on the  
examiner and I would like to ask  
a few questions. I operate a small fishing  
vessel from Crosshaven. My fishing methods  
consist of lines, nets, and pots. The  
area I work in almost exclusively is  
from Roches Point to the Pollack buoy.  
My pots and nets are shot from the  
shore line out to approximately 6 or 7  
miles from the land.

From the chart on the Irish  
Examiner I assume that this is a new  
dump site. It appears to be a different  
site and further offshore than the  
previous one. I would be obliged if  
you could send me on the coordinates  
of same so that I can put them  
into my chart plotter. I will then be  
able to assess what effect it will have  
on my fishing operation. I am  
also concerned about the loss of buoys  
and buoy lines in the path of vessels  
going to and from the site.
