

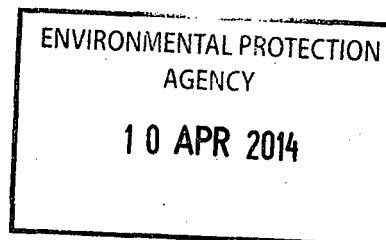


No consultation reports have been received from the above at the time of issue of this correspondence. Accordingly, the Environmental Health (EH) Service response to the proposal is as follows.
