Dear Ms Oglesby,

This Waste Licence Review Application has now been considered by the Environmental Health Service of the HSE. The application was also referred to the Emergency Planning, Estates and Health Protection Services of the HSE on 14 April.

The assessment is based on a review of documentation submitted to this office on 14 April and 13 May by Lennon Quarries Ltd and a site visit conducted on 10 June. All commitments to future actions including mitigation and further testing have been taken as read and all data results have been accepted as accurate. No additional investigations or measurements were undertaken. The following is recommended:

- that the water used for drinking purposes on site be potable and in compliance with the European Communities (Drinking Water) Regulations 2014.

The Environmental Health Service in Mayo has no history of complaints from this facility and has no further comment.
