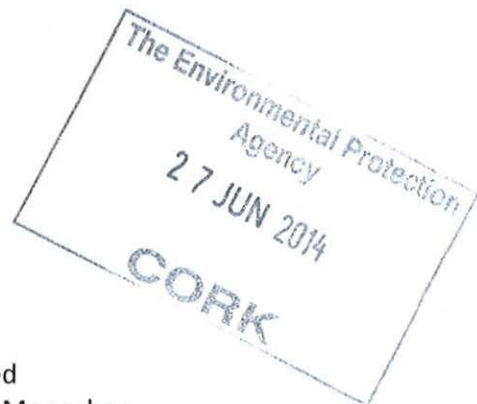

I refer to correspondence received from your office dated 25th June 2014 in respect of the following development:

Licence Application Reference No. P0948-01

The planning history of the relevant site is as follows:

P/11/59: Demolish 4 no. existing agricultural buildings and to construct 2no. poultry/layer houses, 1no. egg store and 1no. manure store, together with all ancillary structures, (to include meal storage bins, soiled water tanks etc) and all associated site works (to include new/upgraded site entrance and construction of piers, wing walls and site boundary fencing) associated with the above proposed development. This application relates to a development, which is for the purposes of an activity requiring an Integrated Pollution Prevention and Control (I.P.P.C.) Licence under part IV of the Environmental Protection Agency (Licensing) Regulations 1994 to 2008.

P/11/350: Revise plans to provide for an increase in size of 1 No. Egg store and 1 No. Manure Store (previously approved under planning file number 11/59), together with all ancillary structures and associated site works associated with the above proposed development.

The parent planning permission relating to the site in question was obtained under planning permission reference P/11/59. The documentation submitted as part of this planning application indicates that 54,000 laying hens would be accommodated within the 2 proposed hen houses.

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
