



Appeal Re: Construct gas terminal for the reception and separation of gas from the Corrib gas field and for a peat deposition site. Bellagelly South, Srahmore, Attavally, Bangor Erris, Co.Mayo.

Dear Deputy,

An Bord Pleanála has received your letter dated 27th May 2004 in which you intended to make an appeal under the Planning and Development Acts, 2000 to 2002.

Section 127(1)(e) of the 2000 Act provides that an appeal must be accompanied by the acknowledgement by the planning authority of receipt of submissions or observations on the application. As your appeal was not accompanied by the said acknowledgment, it is regretted that it must be regarded as invalid in accordance with section 127(2)(a) of the Act. To lodge a valid appeal you must comply with ALL of the requirements of section 127.

You are reminded that the final date for the lodgement of a valid appeal is 4 weeks beginning on the day of the decision by the planning authority. In this case, the time period to lodge a valid appeal has expired.


However, section 130 of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 allows for submissions or observations to be made in writing to the Board in relation to the appeal by any person other than a party to the appeal.

The appropriate period for the making of observations is within 4 weeks beginning on the day of receipt of the last appeal by the Board. The last appeal was received on 27th May 2004.

In addition, where notice of receipt of an environmental impact statement is published, observations can be made within the period of 4 weeks beginning on the day of publication of the notice. The Board proposes to publish the said notice in the near future.

The documents lodged by you and a cheque for the money lodged are enclosed.
