The NW Mayo Development Action Group was formed a number of years ago when we learned that the peat burning power station at Bellacorick was due to close in 2005. Our group is made up of employees from both the ESB and Bord na Mona. We are seeking to improve the infrastructural facilities in NW Mayo which should help the development of the economy in the area. If the facilities that are available in area are on a par with the rest of the country, then North Mayo would have an equal opportunity to develop.

We believe that the Comb Project is a real opportunity to develop the natural resources of the area. It has the potential to provide one of the key pieces of infrastructure that could form the basis for much needed employment in a part of the County where the population is in decline because of emigration due to the lack of employment opportunities. If the project goes ahead, then there is the potential to develop an energy condor along the gas pipeline running through the BMW region.

The group is supporting the development of the Corrib Gas Field and the building of a terminal at Ballinaboy for the refining of gas, provided it complies conditions specified by An Board Pleanála that are based on good environmental practices.
