

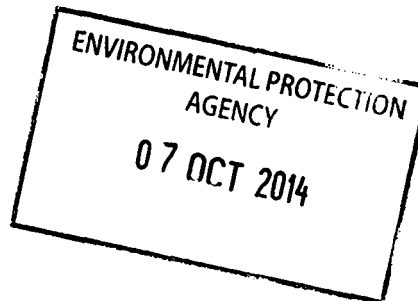

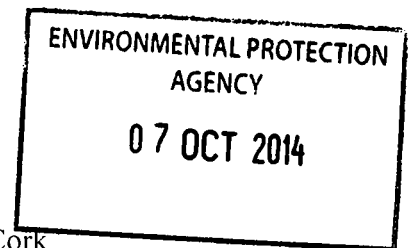

- This report refers only to those sections of the documents which are relevant to the HSE.


**Observations/Recommendations**
